Each project will be "judged" by a Science Fair Judge. The judges are excited to learn about the hard work that the students put into their projects and ask them questions! Students will be required to remain with their projects during their assigned judging session and may explore the Science Fair during the other judging session. Judging Session 1 will be from 6:40-7:20pm and Judging Session 2 will be from 7:30-8:00pm. Judging sessions and table assignments will be sent to participants a few days before the event.
